

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Child's Name	
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Use this checklist to see what the child knows. Do not approach this as a test or call it a test. It may be best to complete this chart over several small units of time instead of in one sitting. Mark the answers that are correct and skip any sections which the child is unable to do. Remember that it is very normal for children this age to not retain much of this information yet. Have the appropriate supplies gathered before beginning.

Letters: Give the child a tactile letter. Ask him to name and say the phonetic sound of the letter. Then ask him to correctly form the letter by tracing it. For your notes, you may want to make a distinction between the errors that occurred: name, phonetic sound, and/or tracing.






