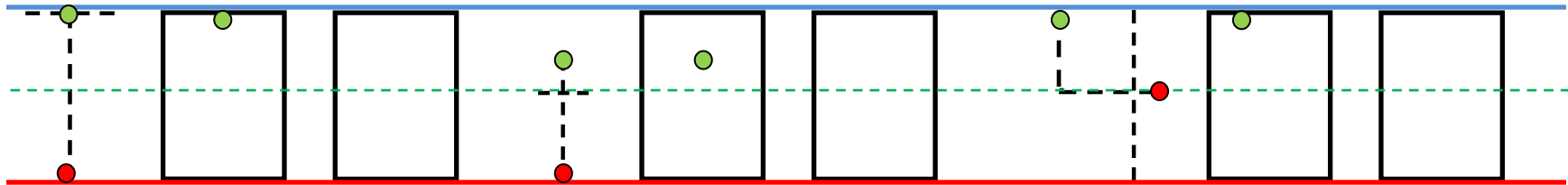
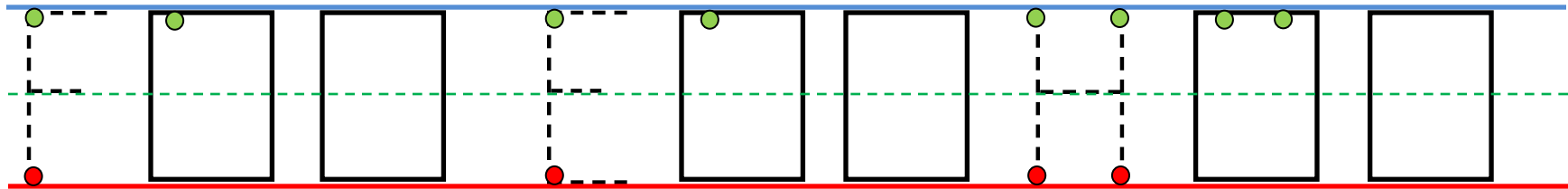
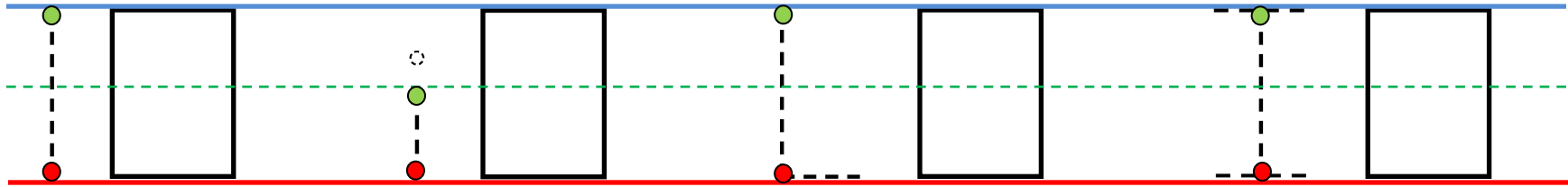


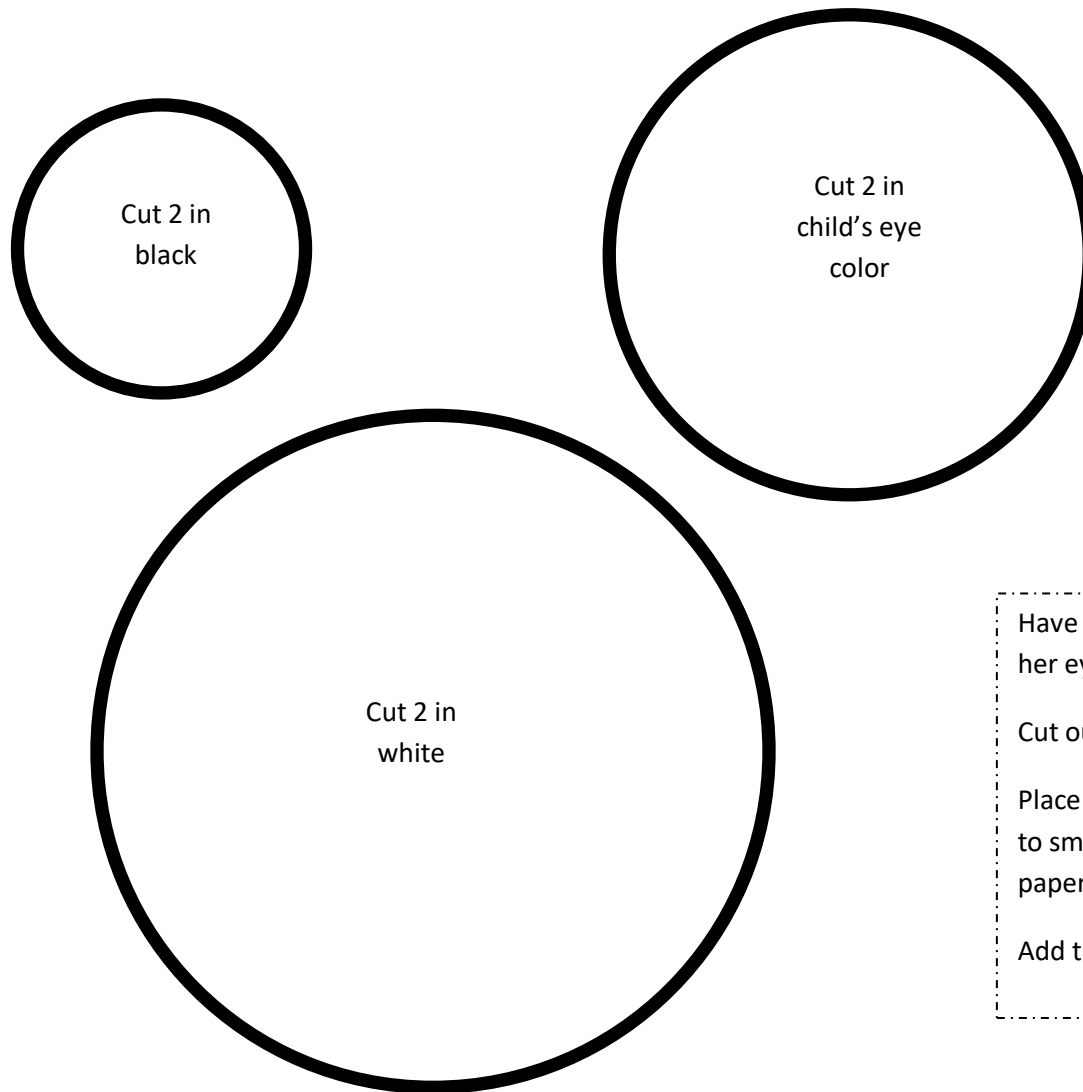
Straight Line Characters

L - body, leg
l - body
E - body, head, arm, leg

H - body, body, hold hands
F - body, head, arm
T - body, roof
t - down, cross
4 - Down and over and down some more.
That's the way to make a four!

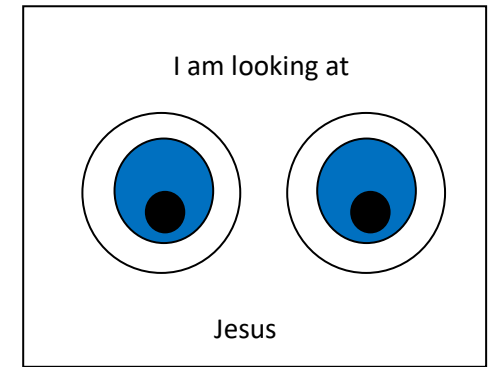
Craft Idea for the Bible Story:

her eyes to see the three main colors.

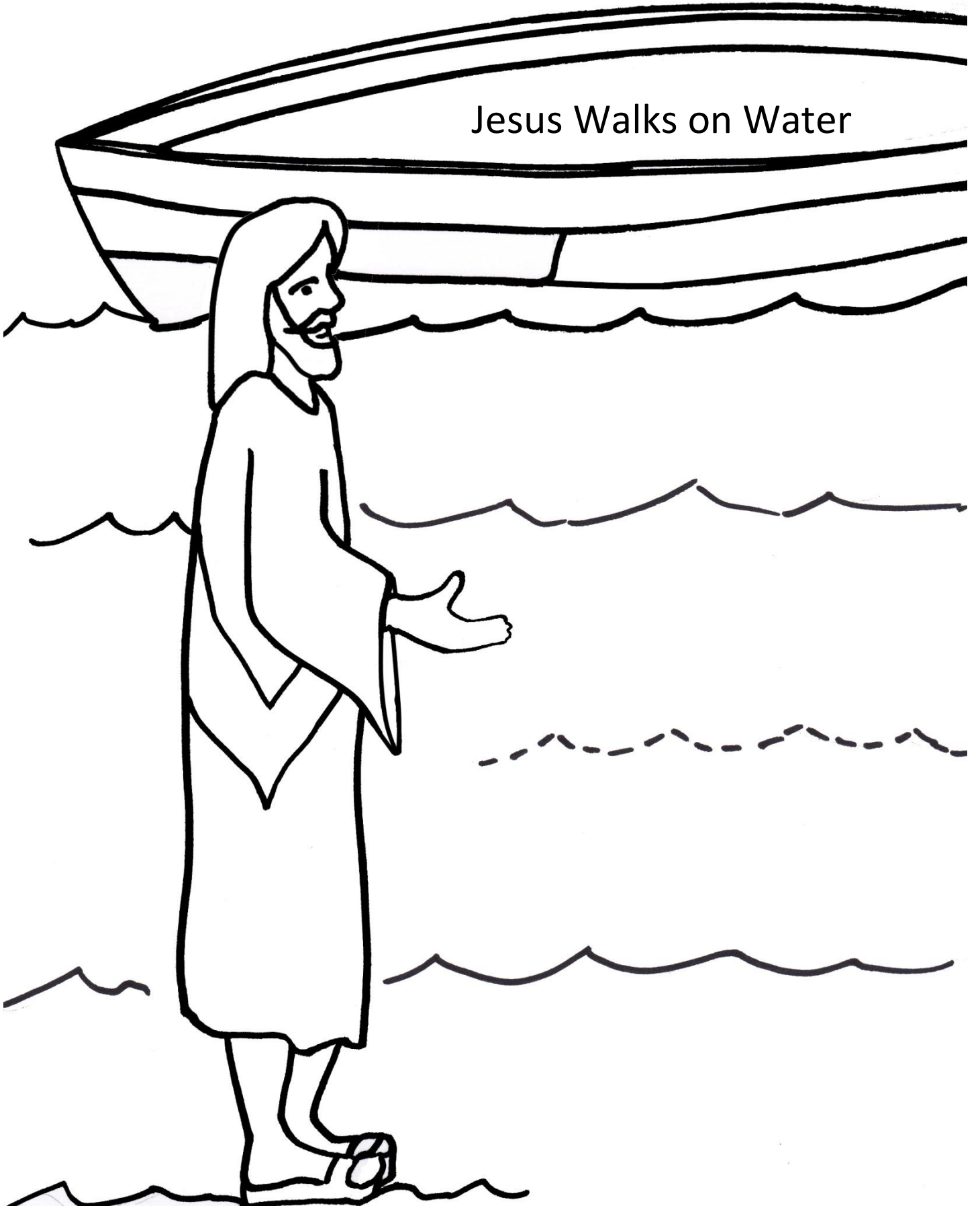
Cut out the circles on the printable.
